History of English Settlement Church

This area became home for several English families in the

1840s. First mention of religious services comes from 1843 when meetings were held in homes. From 1844 until 1846, Sunday services took place in school houses. In the spring of 1846, a plan for a new chapel was decided upon. Letters asking for donations were sent to friends and relatives in England. These supporters helped build a fine structure which has undergone continual improvement since first erected. Our most recent interior renovation was completed in 1997, and air conditioning was added in 2002. The basement was updated in 2017 after the flooding in Burlington. Exterior updates included roof replacement and repainting in 2020. Many people have commented on the beautiful sounds the carillon directs to the countryside. This was first given to us as a memorial and was dedicated in June of 1965. Such is the witness of this Christian church to the community. Of course, the story of our church is really told in the lives of all the friends and members who take part in the various activities. We are always seeking innovative ideas and participation from the community.

Our church is part of the diverse and dynamic Wisconsin Conference of the United Methodist Church. Our symbol as a denomination is the cross and flame. We see the cross as a symbol of the risen Christ who is leading us in a demanding world. The flame represents the Holy Spirit – always ablaze, ever beginning!

Application Information

English Settlement United Methodist Church welcomes your application for a High School Scholarship.

Eligibility:

 The recipient must be a graduating student that is a member of English Settlement United Methodist Church, display a commendable academic record and the potential to successfully continue achievement in a post-secondary college or university. This includes a junior college or technical college when the full credit load is acceptable to a degree granting institution. The attending college may be public or private and the course of study must lead toward a baccalaureate or

- associate degree. Joining or enlisting in a branch of the military is also acceptable.
- The academic course of study selected is the choice of the student and not a factor in the selection process. It is deemed that the arts, letters, sciences, education, agriculture, business, trades, military etc., are all an integral part of the American way of life.
- 3. The recipient will have demonstrated leadership ability and service as evidenced by school, community, and church involvement.

Recipient Selection

The responsibility for selecting the recipient from any given high school rests entirely with the English Settlement United Methodist Church PPRC / Administrative Board. The only limitation imposed by English Settlement United Methodist Church is that the above eligibility requirements are followed as closely as possible.

Recipients will be notified by the English Settlement United Methodist Church PPRC / Administrative Board when they are selected.

Distribution of Funds

The recipient must initiate schooling within 8 months of receiving the award (in name only) and will receive the actual funds as follows from English Settlement United Methodist Church.

- One-half upon receipt of proof of successful completion of the first semester at a postsecondary technical college or university.
 - i.e.: Report Card or Certificate of Basic Training Completion. (Note: The ESUMC Ad Board reserves the right to make one full distribution of the funds.)
- b) One-half after completion of the second semester upon same proof.
- c) Full distribution upon satisfactorily completing basic training in a branch of the military.
